



## Green Coffee Guide 2020 www.singingrooster.org

Singing Rooster's green coffee comes from all coffee regions across Haiti. All beans are 100% Arabica (washed & honey processed).

Haitian coffee has a mild acidity, rich chocolate flavors with notes of citrus. Different roast levels reveal black currant with notes of amaretto, orange peel and sweet nuts.

Haitian coffee makes the PERFECT base for espresso applications. We use a mélange of 70% Haitian & then add other origins depending on our goal.

### Roasting Profiles: we use a hybrid drum/air roaster; this is what we've found:

**Blue Pine Forest** is classically Caribbean in every sense -- chocolatey sweet with mellow citrus-highlights. It's a perfect cup for those who like to ease into the day or relax with coffee after work. A medium dark roast reveals a rich, baker's chocolate-caramel flavor with floral notes and dark fruit.

**Three Mountains [Mare Blanch, Tete Source, Collin]:** when roasted to a Full City, this coffee reveals a black currant flavor with notes of amaretto, orange peel and sweet nuts. Three Mountains won Haiti's first cupping competition.

**Baptiste & Savan Zombie** can take the punch of a dark roast but excel at just under 2nd crack. Notes of sugar, caramel, nougat, nutty. Spicy, floral. Well balanced cups with a fruity surprise.

**Singing Rooster Honey Processed:** easy does the roasting -- go slower & on the lighter side. Go too dark and you'll lose the subtle wine-like qualities. Intense, sweet milk chocolate, dry strawberries & raisins with a grapefruit finish.
